The low budget debut of young Slovak director takes place in Bratislava's neighbourhood Petržalka that evokes both the atmosphere of the periphery, and the small town. It is here that the story of two hapless friends down on their luck begins. One day Mike is attacked by two gangsters who steal his bike. Peter is left by his girlfriend, because she assumes he's gay. Our two friends go for a change. They make a deal: Mike helps Peter to become a proper man-like guy, and Peter in turn teaches Mike how to understand a woman's soul. Peter likes Mike's sister Veronica, but she likes someone else... At the moment when things start going in the right direction, they meet Hungarian tourist Zoltan, who has just been mugged. They decide to help him. Zoltan becomes a catalyst for events in the story, as intimate details of the characters' lives are revealed through him.
